CHARACTER REQUIREMENTS

- No unexcused absences
- No disciplinary referrals

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Students must have a 3.0 or higher GPA at two academic checkpoints:
 - At the end of the 1st semester
 - At the end of the 3rd nine weeks

LEADERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Meet deadlines of Academic Letter Requirements
- Submit all information by April 1.

SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

- Complete 30 hours of community Service from June 1-April 1 of academic year
- Submit information on the Academic Letter Form (Hyperlink this with the questions How has community service helped you become a better person? OR How did your community service benefit someone or improve our community?)
- Teacher aide community service is capped at 5 hours.
