



## IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

All students entering grade 7 are required by Ohio school law to show proof of the following immunizations **BEFORE** starting school:

- **TDaP** vaccine (to protect from Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis)
- **Meningococcal (A, C, Y, W-135)** vaccine (to protect from Meningitis)
  - *Menveo, Menactra OR MenQuadfi*

***Any 7th grade student who has not had TDaP and Meningitis (A, C, Y, W-135) vaccinations will not be permitted to attend school until proof of these immunizations has been received by the school.***

Both the required TDaP and Meningitis (A, C, Y, W-135) shots can be obtained at any time from now until the first day of 7<sup>th</sup> grade. We encourage you to contact your Primary Care Physician or your local Health Department for an appointment. Don't wait, clinics tend to become very busy toward the end of summer.
