GPA & CLASS RANK

All subjects are used to calculate class rank and cumulative grade point average with the exception of physical education courses and select intervention courses.

COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS (CCP) COURSES

Students earn both high school and college credits for CCP courses. CCP courses offered at GlenOak are taught by a high school teachers with adjunct professor status per university standards. GlenOak has CCP partnerships with the following universities: Kent State Stark, Malone University and Stark State College of Technology.
