

2021-2022 GLENOAK HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR EDUCATIONAL OPTION



An educational option is available at GlenOak High School for seniors who wish to use their study hall period to further their education outside of school by doing community service, conducting research on a Chromebook, doing schoolwork in groups, or using the time for homework.

The release time cannot be used for employment purposes. On occasion, seniors will need to report to GlenOak during their Senior Option for school functions such as special testing, senior meetings, and graduation practice. Failure to be in attendance when required will result in disciplinary action as well as loss of the Senior Educational Option.

Senior Option will only be granted in 90-minute durations except during 1st and 7th periods. Students are expected to leave the building immediately during Senior Option. If there is a violation of this policy, Senior Option will be revoked.

Please note: Senior Option begins only after a parent/guardian signs this form, Final Forms are complete and up to date, and the student returns this application to their Academy Secretary. Schedules will be changed once the Academy Principal grants approval based on the verification of information. No class schedule will be changed to provide a study hall for seniors.

CRITERIA FOR OBTAINING AND MAINTAINING THE SENIOR EDUCATIONAL OPTION:

- All outstanding fines/fees must be paid prior to receiving Senior Option
- Final Forms are complete and up to date
- 2.5 GPA is required for the previous semester
- Senior is compliant with the 12th grade Meningococcal Vaccine requirement
- Appropriate progress towards graduation requirements is being made
- Student must have NO discipline referrals and NO suspensions from the previous semester
- All assignments must be up to date
- Appropriate attendance is required
- Prompt arrival and departure are required
- Appropriate behavior is required
- Student must have scheduled appropriate courses to graduate
- Student may use the public area of the library only
- Student may not be credit deficient and must be taking five [5] credits per semester
